Bianco di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli Sicilia 2006 12.5% **£13.95**
Made from local Sicilian grape varieties, this great wine is light bodied yet full of ripe fresh fruit flavour. A crisp fresh finish completes the package.

Tierra Brisa Chardonnay/Torrontes Argentina 2007 13% **£14.95**
The Torrontes adds a pleasant floral character to the fresh, round, soft Chardonnay in this delicious white.

Neblina Merlot Rosé Chile 2006/07 13% **£15.95**
An exciting New World Rosé packed with intense colour and mouthwatering red fruit characters.

Prosecco Frizzante Il Cortigiano N/V 10.5% **£16.95**

Italian Wines

Pinot Grigio Rosé Breganze Veneto 2006/07 12.5% **£15.95**
Soft floral flavours on the palate and a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish.

Verdicchio Croce del Moro Marche 2006 12.5% **£17.95**
A light dry wine, made from a top quality grape variety, Verdicchio. On the nose and palate, there is a fantastic combination of apples and limes making this wine a fresh and zesty aperitif.

Gavi di Gavi Raccolto Tardivo, Villa Lanata Piemonte 2006 13% **£23.95**
Made from the Italian Cortese grape, this ripe, crisp fulsome white is harvested late in the season to give even more grapefruit & apricot intensity, with refined strength.

Rest of the World

Neblina Sauvignon Chile 2007 13% **£15.95**
Youthful, lively and fresh, this Sauvignon Blanc has herbal tropical notes on the nose, followed by a zesty citrus palate.

Domaine Begude Chardonnay France 2006/07 13% **£17.95**
Unoaked to retain optimum fruit flavours, the nose shows crisp citrus, developing into a honeyed, pear-flavoured palate. Clean and fresh on the finish.

Southbank Estate Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, N.Z 2007 13% **£19.95**
Displaying ripe gooseberries followed by crisp, clean acidity and a refreshing finish that are the hallmark of this unmistakable Marlborough Sauvignon.

Champagne

De Telmont Grande Reserve N/V 12% **£34.95**
Medium bodied, with apple and lemon fruit flavours and a classically yeasty style.

RED WINES

Rosso di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli Sicilia 2004/05 12.5% **£11.95**
A warm, rich aroma, followed by classic Italian morello cherry flavours and a light fresh finish.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Moncaro Marche 2005 12.5% **£14.95**
A rich, cherry-flavoured wine that fully reflects the excellent vineyard sites Moncaro have in the Marche region of Italy.

Emiliana Adobe, Organic Merlot Chile 2005 14.5% **£14.95**
Deep cherry-red in colour, it shows intense strawberry and raspberry aromas, subtly lifted by notes of chocolate and cream.

Italian Wines

Aglianico Rosso di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli Sicilia 2004/05 13.5% **£15.95**
Wonderfully aromatic produced in the sunny Mediterranean climate of Sicily renowned for producing soft and fruity wines. Typically spicy on the nose with juicy berry characters and a long and velvety finish.

Chianti Loggia del Conte Toscana 2005 12.5% **£16.95**
Made from the Sangiovese and Canaiolo grapes, this wine has delightful aromas of cherries and violets and youthful red fruit flavours on the palate.

Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Veneti, Negrar Veneto 2005 12.5% **£17.95**
A richly cherried wine with a smooth marzipan finish. A wonderful step above your average Valpolicella.

Dogajolo Carpineto Toscana 2004/05 13% **£22.95**
Dogajolo is an innovative wine whereby the Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes are vinified separately then allowed to harmonise in oak barrels to produce a soft and intensely fruity wine.

Sedara Nero d'Avola, Donnafugata Sicilia 2005 14% **£23.95**
This unusual wine is made from the finest of Sicilian grapes, Nero d'Avola– and shows its characters in tobacco and spice notes shining through the blackberry and black cherry fruit.

Barbera d'Alba Sucule, Villa Lanata Piemonte 2003 14% **£24.95**
A lush, Morello Cherry packed Italian classic full of smooth, creamy fruit and a wonderfully warming finish. A "log fire" wine.

Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Cantina di Negrar Veneto 2003 15% **£39.95**
A classic Amarone from vineyards located in the heart of the Negrar hills. The fruity bouquet shows black cherries and prunes, as well as a hint of sweet spice.

Other Wines

Neblina Merlot Chile 2006 13% **£14.95**
On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours.

Bellevue Hill Shiraz Australia 2005 13.5% **£16.95**
A superb Aussie Shiraz with masses of juicy blackcurrant fruit and a charismatic, smooth, spicy and peppery finish.

Rioja Reserva, Berberana Spain 2002 13% **£22.95**
A beautifully balanced Rioja. Loads of ripe strawberry fruit with hints of coffee and vanilla and a mel-low lingering finish.
